Dear Parents/Guardians,

Fairview is very excited to continue our Positive School-Wide Behavior Program, Fairview Principal's 100 Club. The goal of this program is to: (1) assure a positive school environment (respectful, responsible, and safe). (2) increase desirable, prosocial student behaviors, (3) decrease bullying, teasing, defiance, disrespect, and (4) provide multiple levels of praise for the student, plus positive communication with parents.

Staff members all over the building will be "catching" students showing exemplary behaviors. Some examples of exemplary behaviors could include: random acts of kindness, demonstrating respectful behavior, especially in difficult circumstances, being courteous and polite, stepping up to help in an incident when someone is being teased or bullied, being extra helpful to adults or to other students, using excellent table manners, demonstrating fairness and good sportsmanship, accepting consequences respectfully, as well as many other behaviors that staff might encounter.

Students "caught" displaying exemplary behaviors will receive a yellow "Way to Go!" ticket from any of our staff members. If your child is awarded with this ticket, they will report to the office after their recess time. They will sign Fairview's Celebrity Book of Fame, and pick a number from 1 to 100. Their name will be placed on the 100's board in the office with that corresponding number. That student will receive a positive ticket home, a small prize, and their name will be read over the morning announcements. Once we have a complete line of 10 numbers, across, up and down, or diagonally, each of those 10 students will receive a Fairview Principal's 100 Club t-shirt.

This is a positive way for us to show our students how proud we are of how well-behaved they are and how they make a positive influence at Fairview Elementary. It is also our way of thanking parents/guardians for your continued support and guidance at home. As a team, we will continue to achieve Fairview's Panther Pride!!
