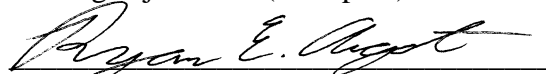
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Ellen Hopkins, Lewisberry, expressed concerns about the Request for Proposals of Legal Services.
