The West Shore School Board met in regular session at 6:39 p.m. with President Guistwhite presiding.

Opening Ceremonies The opening ceremonies were led by Red Land High School's JROTC Color Guard comprised of Junior Maya Jovic, Sophomores Weston Stoner and Xavier Zarza with Freshman Madison Gray while the National Anthem was performed by Eighth graders Jachin Derk, Austin Hutcheson, Dylan Kovacevic, Noah Musselman, and Benjamin Rosenberger from Crossroads Middle School Band.

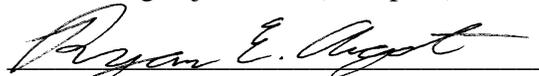
