The student branch of New Cumberland Federal Credit Union is a partnership between the Red Land High School and NCFCU. The branch is open when school is in session on Wednesdays and Fridays from 10:30am to 1:30pm and is located across the lobby from the gymnasium, through the double doors. The student branch is operated by a team of trained Red Land students and supervised by an NCFCU employee. The student branch will allow Red Land students/parents, faculty and staff to take advantage of the products and services offered by NCFCU and act as a tool to help students gain banking and financial literacy skills before entering the real world.

The goal of the Student Branch Banking Program at NCFCU is to nurture young people in the community into financially productive adults. To achieve this goal we:

- Take a hands-on approach in teaching students about banking and financial literacy in a secure and convenient setting at their school.
- Offer age appropriate financial products, services and savings programs.
- Conduct classroom presentations on various banking and money management topics.
- Participate and support school functions such as Back to School Night, The Patriot Challenge, Financial Aid Night, etc.
- Provide employability skills to the volunteers operating the student branch.

Benefits to Red Land students:

- NCFCU will add \$5 to the student's new savings account to get them started.
- If the student deposits \$5 or more of their own money the day they open their account they will receive a Red Land draw string back pack.

Student Accounts:

- Savings Account* (required for membership) – students of any age can open a savings account.
- Checking Account* – students under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian as joint owner on a checking account.
- Debit/ATM cards* – students under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian sign permission on the membership application stating the student is allowed to have a plastic card.

* Students will need to fill out a membership application including signatures and social security number, and present their school ID or drivers license.
