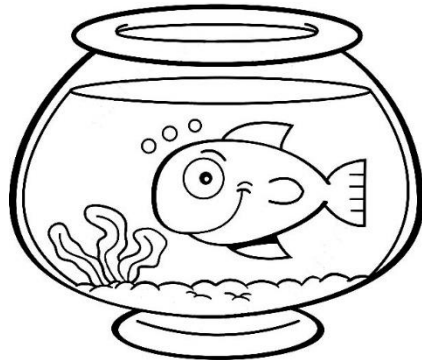


Fishbowl Question Search

This activity was developed to provide students with continued support on questioning strategies in a fun and interactive way. Students will answer “right there”, “think and search”, and “author and me” questions. The directions are as follows:

Directions:

1. Print question sheet provided below.
2. Cut questions into strips, fold them up, and throw them in a bowl.
 - To keep the materials long lasting, questions could be laminated, pasted to popsicle sticks, etc.
3. Have students pick questions from the bowl as they read.
4. Have student answer the questions based off of what they have read.
