Flexible Scheduling for Seniors

Early Release and Late Start Options are a privilege given to seniors who are on target to meet the necessary graduation requirement of 22.0 credits. Seniors attending high school must minimally enroll in two (2) credits at their respective high school while most seniors are in need of four (4) credits to achieve the 22.0 required credits. In order to be scheduled for less than a six (6) credit course load, students must provide their own transportation to allow for the flexible scheduling, and parents/guardians must confirm that their child will be employed part-time or officially enrolled in post-secondary coursework. PIAA requires all athletes to pass four (4) credits for high school athletic eligibility. Potential collegiate athletes seeking NCAA Division I or NCAA Division II eligibility should give serious consideration to taking a six (6) credit academic course load and must consult the NCAA Eligibility Center.
