## PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Our goal is to maintain a minimum of 3-6 feet of distance in all areas.



## MASKS & FACE COVERINGS

Following guidance from the state, staff, students, and visitors must wear a face covering. Exceptions will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

## TRANSPORTATION

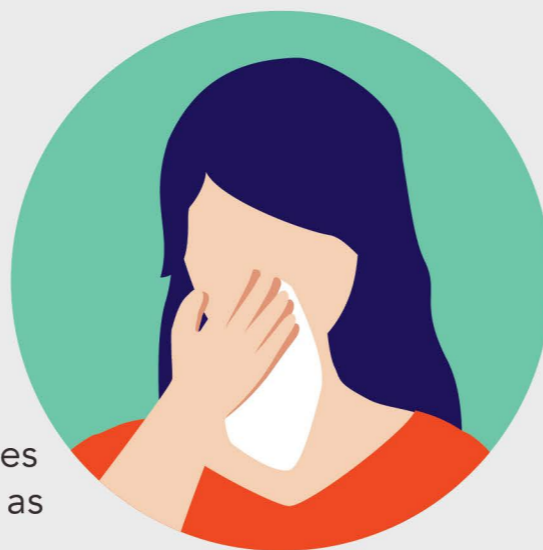
Buses will be sanitized after trips. Windows and roof hatches will be open when possible for increased ventilation.

## DAILY MONITORING OF SYMPTOMS

Parents will be asked to support school health by keeping children home if they are sick or symptomatic.

Designated isolation containment areas will be used for students exhibiting symptoms while awaiting pick up.

Attendance policies will be adapted as needed.



## CLEAN AND DISINFECT

Cleaning and disinfecting protocols will occur on a regular basis with high touch surfaces given priority.

HVAC systems will be adjusted when possible to increase fresh air and follow ASHRAE, EPA, and CDC guidance.

Signage will be used to remind students and staff of hygiene practices.

Hand washing routines will be followed and sanitizing products available.



## LUNCH & RECESS

Physical distancing will occur to the greatest extent possible. Buildings may create additional dining spaces where appropriate. Time for hand washing will be provided prior to lunch and upon return from breakfast and recess.

## OUTDOOR SPACES

Staff and students will utilize outdoor learning spaces where appropriate.



## ALTERNATE LEARNING

All students will have devices for home use and hotspots if needed.

West Shore also has a cyber school option (CAOLA) for all K-12 students.
