Authority Purpose

It shall be the policy of this <u>The</u> Board to <u>shall</u> supply each <u>teaching</u> staff member and student with the supplies and equipment that are deemed necessary for the implementation of the approved <u>educational</u> program. [1]

Where the foregoing requirements impose a financial hardship on a student, the School District will assume the cost. The Superintendent shall devise procedures assuring that no student need be denied participation in the school program for financial reasons while at the same time guarding the privacy of each student.

The Board may require that students provide certain supplies for <u>participation in the conduct of</u> co-curricular <u>and extracurricular</u> activities.

Guidelines

When individualized and nonreusable clothing or equipment is necessary for reasons of safety or health, students shall be required to provide their own clothing or equipment, which shall meet standards set by the school. Such standards shall be reasonably related to considerations of safety, health, and protection of property.[2]

Where the foregoing requirements impose a financial hardship on a student, the District will assume the cost.

When students prepare useful items they are permitted to keep, the District may require the student to pay the cost of the materials used. Additionally, the Board may require that students provide certain supplies for the conduct of extracurricular and co-curricular activities.

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent or designee shall establish administrative regulations to ensure that no student is denied participation in the educational program for financial reasons and to guard the privacy of each student.
