Directions for taking a Summer Academy course via Schoology

Step One: Logging into Schoology

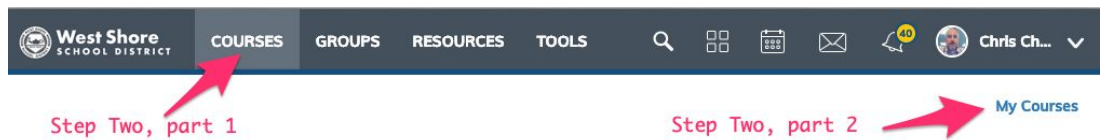
Go to <https://wssd.schoology.com/> (not www)

User name: your wssd.bz account (typically lastname, first initial @wssd.bz e.g. doej@wssd.bz)

Password: your regular password for email, PowerSchool, etc.

Step Two: Sign Up for Your Course

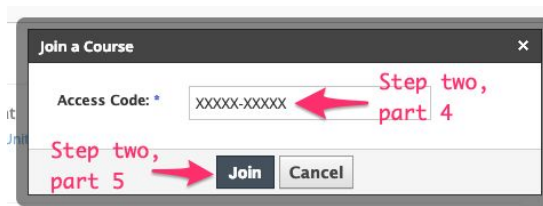
(1) Click on the “Course” menu, then (2) click on “My Courses”



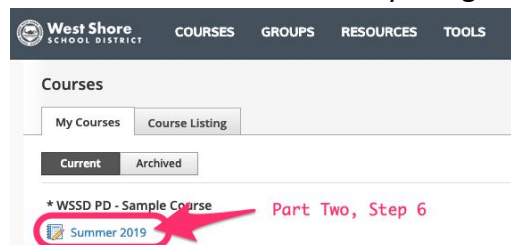
Then, (3) click on “Join Course”.



(4) Enter the course code from the “Schoology Course Codes” document (see staff website), then (5) click “Join”




(6) In your list of courses, you should now see the course you signed up for. Click on “Summer 2019”



Once you sign up, you will be able to see the course you enrolled in each time you log in. Click “Courses” at the top to access your course at any time.


Step Three: Navigating Your Course

Begin by clicking on the “Start Here” folder:




