**Volunteer Affirmation**

**Although West Shore School District welcomes and encourages volunteers in its schools and classrooms, for the safety of District students and staff members, any adult wishing to volunteer is required to complete the Volunteer Application Process before being approved to do so.**

I affirm that I have never been charged, arrested, indicted or convicted of an offense or offenses specified under 24 P.S. § 1-11(e) or (f.1) (“Reportable Offenses”). Further, I affirm I have never been named as a perpetrator of a founded report of serious bodily injury, sexual abuse, or sexual exploitation of a child. See next page for more information.

As a new volunteer, I will provide the building principal or designee an original Act 34 PA Criminal History Record Check, and an Act 151 PA Child Abuse History Certification (clearance) from the Pennsylvania Department of Education (version obtained at my expense that is less than one year old at the time of submission). Furthermore, if I have not lived in Pennsylvania continuously for the past ten (10) years, I will provide an Act 114 FBI Criminal History Clearance (fingerprint) obtained at my expense. If I have lived in Pennsylvania for the past ten (10) years, I will sign the Exemption (Waiver) attached to this application.

As a new volunteer, I will provide the building principal or designee evidence of a tuberculosis (TB) test, obtained at my own expense, that is less than ninety (90) days old at the time of submission unless information from my primary health care provider indicates that a TB test is contraindicated due to a tuberculin allergy or prior positive TB results.

As a returning volunteer, I understand that I must provide new certifications (clearances) every five (5) years (calculated 5 calendar years from the date of the oldest clearance).

I have read the Guidelines for Volunteers including the Confidentiality Agreement and agree to comply with all its terms.

## LIST OF REPORTABLE OFFENSES

**A reportable offense enumerated under 24 P.S. § 1-114(e) consists of any of the following:**

(1) An offense under one or more of the following provisions of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes:

- Chapter 25 (relating to criminal homicide)
- Section 2702 (relating to aggravated assault)
- Section 2709.1 (relating to stalking)
- Section 2901 (relating to kidnapping)
- Section 2902 (relating to unlawful restraint)
- Section 2910 (relating to luring a child into a motor vehicle or structure)
- Section 3121 (relating to rape)
- Section 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual assault)
- Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual intercourse)
- Section 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault)
- Section 3124.2 (relating to institutional sexual assault)
- Section 3125 (relating to aggravated indecent assault)
- Section 3126 (relating to indecent assault)
- Section 3127 (relating to indecent exposure)
- Section 3129 (relating to sexual intercourse with animal)
- Section 4302 (relating to incest)
- Section 4303 (relating to concealing death of a child)
- Section 4304 (relating to endangering welfare of children)
- Section 4305 (relating to dealing in infant children)
- A felony offense under section 5902(b) (relating to prostitution and related offenses)
- Section 5903(c) or (d) (relating to obscene and other sexual materials and performances)
- Section 6301(a)(1) (relating to corruption of minors)
- Section 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children)
- Section 6318 (relating to unlawful contact with minor)
- Section 6319 (relating to solicitation of minors to traffic drugs)
- Section 6320 (relating to sexual exploitation of children)

(2) An offense designated as a felony under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act."

(3) An offense SIMILAR IN NATURE to those crimes listed above in clauses (1) and (2) under the laws or former laws of:

The United States; or one of its territories or possessions; or another state; or the District of Columbia; or the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico; or a foreign nation; or under a former law of this Commonwealth

**A reportable offense enumerated under 24 P.S. § 1-114(f.1) consists of any of the following:**

- (1) An offense graded as a felony offense of the first, second or third degree, other than one of the offenses enumerated under 24 P.S. §1-114 (e), if less than (10) years has elapsed from the date of expiration of the sentence for the offense.
- (2) An offense graded as a misdemeanor of the first degree, other than one of the offenses enumerated under 24 P.S. §1-114 (e), if less than (5) years has elapsed from the date of expiration of the sentence for the offense.
- (3) An offense under 75 Pa.C.S. § 3802(a), (b), (c) or (d) (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance) graded as a misdemeanor of the first degree under 75 Pa.C.S. § 3803 (relating to grading), if the person has been previously convicted of such an offense and less than (3) three years has elapsed from the date of expiration of the sentence for the most recent offense.
