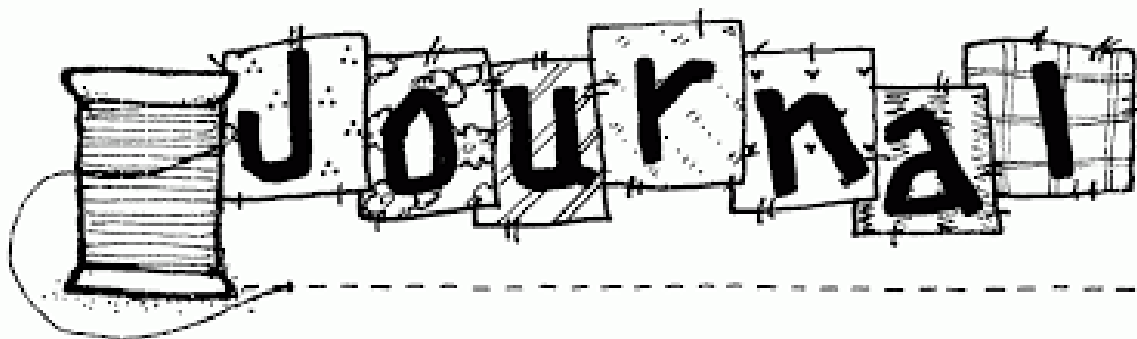


Write To Me Journal

Directions for Parent/Guardian:

Make writing real and fun by engaging in everyday writing with your student!

Below you will find five writing prompts for parent/ guardians and students to practice with. This activity will focus on improving students' writing ability by incorporating it into everyday life.
