## Fantastic Fluency

For children to understand what they read, they must be able to read *fluently* whether they are reading aloud or silently. Fluent readers read with accuracy, proper expression, and at a good rate. What can parents do at home to help their child become a fluent reader?

 $\Box$  Choose the right books- Help your child choose books he/she can comfortably read. There should be 5 words or fewer that give them trouble on each page.

 $\Box$  Listen to your child read every day.

□ Read it again- Encourage your child to reread favorite books, or poems and make it fun! Repeated readings improve children's fluency and comprehension.

Read to your child every day- Model your own fluent reading as you enjoy reading books with your child! It could be a picture book or a chapter a night.
Enjoy listening to your child become a fluent reader!
